Harry G. Hellbusch, 85, lifetime Nance county resident and former Fullerton City employee, died February 15 in Fullerton Manor where he had resided for a short time.

He was born on December 28, 1902, to Hinrich and Gesine (Engabart) Hellbusch. He grew up in the Belgrade area and attended rural schools. On February 20, 1929, he married Lena Naeve in Peace Lutheran Church near Belgrade. The couple farmed in the Timber Creek area until 1945 when they moved into Fullerton where he was employed by Cedar Valley Lumber for 15 years and by the City of Fullerton for 10 years.

He was a member of Mt. Calvary Lutheran Church and the Eagles Aerie here.

Surviving besides his wife are a daughter, Mrs. Ronald (Joyce) Anderson of Fullerton, two brothers, August Hellbusch of Westminster, Colorado, and Walter Hellbusch of Belgrade; five grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, seven brothers and three sisters.
