

# Obituary

Albion - Leona Margreta Naeve, 82 of Albion died December 17, 1998, at her home.

Services were December 21 at Zion Lutheran Church in Albion. The Rev. Brian Bergum officiated. Burial was at Peace Lutheran Cemetery near Belgrade.

Mrs. Naeve was born on June 16, 1916, at Belgrade to George and Anna (Oldigs) Hellbusch. She attended elementary school at Red Wing School near Belgrade and then attended Cedar Rapids High School.

She was married to Louis Naeve on October 21, 1936. They lived and farmed south of Belgrade until 1945, when they moved to Lyons. They later moved to Craig and farmed there until moving to a farm east of Albion in 1953.
